ABSTRACT AND FULL PAPER : One page Abstract (Word limit: 250 words) or Full paper (will be published in the symposium proceedings with ISBN) (word limit: 5000 words, maximum 6-8 pages) that include all Figures, Tables, References etc. The page size should be A4 (210 mm x 297 mm) with 25 mm margin on all sides. The font should be Times New Roman with size as indicated in different parts.

Title of the paper (bold, Size 14), Full names of authors (e.g. John Smith, Manoj Singh...) (Size 12), Affiliation (italicized. Size 10), (all of the above must be Centered). Abstract (bold, size 12, Centered) single space. The abstract text should be in font size 10. The line spacing should be 1.5 space in single paragraph. The text should be justified. Figures and Tables should be suitably reduced in size for their appropriate placement in the text, where they are referred to. Each must be numbered (bold, e.g. Fig.1) and must have an appropriate caption (legend) below it. Caption should be italicized.
